PLAN REVIEW: PLAN REVIEW NOT REQUIRED:

Plans must be submitted with an application for Plan Examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as indicated below:

Plans are not required for the following:

- 1. One and two-family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
- 2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
- 3. Assembly, business, mercantile, and storage buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.
- 4. Work being completed by a governmental subdivision or a state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

If work being performed is described above, check "Plan Review Not Required".

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to PA299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

Wales Township will not discriminate against any individual or group because of race, sex, religion, age, national origin, color, marital status, disability or political beliefs. If you need help with reading, writing, hearing, etc...under the Americans with Disabilities Act, you may make your needs known to this agency.

Instructions: No plumbing work shall be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. **Please phone Tim Kelly at (810) 392-2582, with the job location and permit number, in order to schedule your inspections.**

Expiration: A permit remains valid as long as work is in progress and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit becomes invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for

a period of six months after commencing the work. Permit will be closed when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Closed permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.

FEE CLARIFICATION:

#2: MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee, plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

#3b: DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTERING EQUIPMENT: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #3bfor \$5.00 each and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

#21b: MEDICAL GAS SYSTEMS shall include the application fee, one special/safety inspection-medical gas system(21b) and the estimated number of additional inspections in #22.
