## COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC ON AGENDA ITEMS. None.

GUEST PRESENTATION. Carly Kimmen-Wales Township Assessor. The Township has received a copy of a petition to the State Tax Tribunal from Michael Pflueger, Jr., owner of the previously named Leaning Tree Golf Course, naming Township of Wales as Respondent. He is requesting a reduction in values from \$765,795 to \$260,000, a difference of \$505,795. The Assessor says we have until July before the Tax Tribunal meets, but it takes time to prepare if we wish to contest his petition. Messina said an appraisal takes from 3 to 5 months to complete

for commercial property. The Township must have an appraisal and a legal representative to fight this. Bobcean asked if Kimmen thought the petitioner would still be owner in a couple of years. Kimmen said "probably". Bobcean would like to have some time to think about this. Thomson is in favor of proceeding to Court. Masters said we need to be fair to all of the taxpayers. **Motion** by Thomson, second by Masters, that, in agreement with the Assessor, we should proceed with taking this to Court, at least for now. Roll call vote taken: Masters, aye; Shannon, aye; Messina, aye; Bobcean, nay; Thomson, aye. Four ayes; one nay; motion carried.

Kimmen then passed out a paper to Board members concerning mailing of Assessment Tax Notices. She said that many local tax assessors are using a mailing service company in Marysville to do this job. Wales currently has 1,925 records. At the mailing service company's charge of \$0.54 a card, it would cost \$1,039.50. With stamps costing \$0.49 each, plus paper, toner, closing stick-ons, three per notice, man hours, she feels it might be worth mass mailing through that company. Board members agreed with the concept, but said that there are several companies which do the same service, and asked Kimmen if she would be willing to investigate other companies for their prices, reputation, etc. Yes. With that said, **motion** by Masters, second by Messina, to hire a company of her choosing to do the mailing. Roll call vote taken: Masters, aye; Messina, aye; Bobcean, aye; Shannon, aye; Thomson, aye. All ayes; motion carried.
